

"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2023-2024 BUDGET ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT, NORTH CAROLINA
TRANSFERRING FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ONE HIGH POINT COMMISSION'S
FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of High Point, North Carolina, as follows:

Section 1. The proposed amendment transfers \$292,460 for the National Institute of Minority Economic Development (NIMED) Research, Policy and Impact Center proposal for project management, consulting services, and subject matter expertise (SME) related to implementation of the One High Point Commission's report of findings and recommendations, utilizing budget freed up by the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for government services.

Section 2. The 2023-2024 Budget Ordinance of the City of High Point should be amended as follows:


Section 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
