**PURPOSE:** The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is requesting concurrence from the City of High Point regarding a speed limit ordinance update for Kendale Road (SR 1834) between Skeet Club Road and 0.282 miles north of Kendale Road.

**BACKGROUND:** During their review of NCDOT speed limit ordinances in the High Point area, NCDOT found that there was no ordinance in place for the currently posted speed limit of 45 mph on this segment of Kendale Road. This action will ensure that the posted speed limit matches the most current ordinance for both the city and the NCDOT.

**BUDGET IMPACT:** There is no budget impact for this item. Signage is currently in place with the correct speed limit and any additional signing will be provided and installed by NCDOT. Future sign repairs and replacements by City forces will be eligible for reimbursement by NCDOT under Schedule A of a Municipal Traffic Maintenance Agreement, as they are now.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:** The Transportation Department recommends City Council approval of this concurring action requested by NCDOT.
