Capital Project Ordinance

PURPOSE:

To make year-end technical adjustment appropriations for the General Fund, Transit Grants, Transit Capital, and Landfill Development and Post Closure Fund.

BACKGROUND:

The following year-end technical adjustments are needed prior to the close of the fiscal year.

General Fund: An appropriation of \$1,200,000 in lease proceeds to properly record the lease for network storage server equipment that was approved by the City Council in July 2020. All debt service payments have been previously budgeted.

<u>Transit Grants and Transit Capital</u>: Each fiscal year, unspent budget for grants and capital are rolled forward, as allowed per the annual adopted budget ordinance. Several transit grant and transit capital budgets were not included in the budget roll, and therefore a technical budget adjustment is necessary via amendment to reappropriate these funds. The transit grant amount totals \$380,738 and the transit capital amount totals \$458,870.

<u>Landfill Development and Post Closure Fund</u>: A transfer of \$1,221,000 was not included in the adopted budget ordinance. This transfer funds the expansion of the landfill. The projects have been previously budgeted, and this will move the cash to the correct funds.

BUDGET IMPACT:

There is no budget impact. The expenditures and revenues have been previously approved.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTIONS REQUESTED:

The Financial Services Department recommends and asks the City Council to approve the budget amendments.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of High Point, North Carolina, as follows:

- Section 1. Several year-end technical adjustments are needed prior to the close of the fiscal year. These affect the General Fund (lease proceeds), Transit Grants and Transit Capital (budget roll), and the Landfill Development and Post Closure Fund (transfer).
- Section 2. The 2020-2021 Budget Ordinance of the City of High Point should be amended as follows:
- (A) That the following General Fund revenues be amended as follows:

Lease Proceeds \$1,200,000

(B) That the following General Fund expenditures be amended as follows:

Capital Equipment \$1,200,000

(C) That the following Transit Grant revenues be amended as follows:

Federal Grants \$380,738

(D) That the following Transit Grant expenditures be amended as follows:

Expendable Tools and Equipment

\$380,738

(E) That the following Landfill Development and Post Closure Fund revenues be amended as follows:

Fund Balance Appropriation

\$1,221,000

(F) That the following Landfill Development and Post Closure Fund expenditures be amended as follows:

Transfer to Landfill Capital Projects Fund Transfer to Landfill Operations Fund

\$1,000,000 221,000

- Section 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 4. That this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage."
