**PURPOSE:** To highlight High Point 911 Telecommunicators (Baker Team) for being awarded the 2024 Communications Team of the Year award at the North Carolina Association of Public-Safety Officials (APCO) conference.

**BACKGROUND:** On March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024, High Point 911 (Baker Team) received a highly unusual but critical call from an individual in Florida. The individual was reporting a hostage situation in High Point being broadcast via Facetime. Our Telecommunicators responded immediately to the situation. To view the private real-time Facetime stream, Telecommunicators contacted another individual, who was with the caller in Florida, allowing them to view the Facetime broadcast. The High Point Police and Fire Department were contacted for hostage negotiation and medical response. As events unfolded, Telecommunicators provided real-time intelligence to all involved parties, handled other emergent events called into the dispatch center, and even ordered coffee for the negotiators. The situation concluded with the perpetrator being apprehended and the hostage being rescued with no major injuries to either party. Members of Baker team include Joe Meservey, Karen Shearer, David Wilson, Kate Bret, Ashley Garren, and Justin Grose.

In recognition of their professional and attentive response, the High Point 911 Baker Team was awarded the 2024 Communications Team of the Year award at the North Carolina Association of Public-Safety Officials (APCO) conference.
