ELM STREET IMPROVEMENTS

- Improvements from Sunset Avenue to Commerce Avenue
- Reduce travel lanes to one lane in each direction
- Add on-street parking
- 10' minimum side path on the west side (Greenway Connection)
- Improve pedestrian safety with enhanced intersections
 - Pedestrian Signals
 - Decorative Crosswalks
 - Enhanced Landscaping









SOUTHWEST HERITAGE GREENWAY IMPROVEMENTS






FEATHER FLAGS

Prosperity, Livability & Safety Committee March 6, 2025

BACKGROUND

- Committee met on September 12, 2024
- Staff gave an overview of what other similar communities allow
- Committee preferred Wilmington regulations
- Staff researched best fit into High Point Development
 Ordinance





LIMITED DURATION SIGNS

- Allow as a Limited Duration Sign
 - Nonresidential districts for nonresidential uses
 - Residential districts for Outdoor Seasonal Sales only
- Limited Duration Signs include:
 - Inflatable signs
 - Pennants
 - Temporary banner signs
- Allowed two times per year for 30 days
- Each sign type has specific standards relevant to their characteristics
 - Placement
 - Height
 - Size









FEATHER FLAGS

- Amend Section 5.7.3 Prohibited Signs
 - add feather flags as an exception to allow as a limited duration sign
- Amend Section 5.7.12 Limited Duration Signs
 - Add feather flags
 - 1 per 50 lineal feet of lot frontage up to a maximum of 3 flags
 - Max height 10 feet
 - 30 days twice per year
- Amend Section 10.4 Definitions
 - Add feather flags to limited duration sign definition





NEXT STEPS

- If Committee wants to proceed
 - Planning and Zoning Commission Public Hearing
 - City Council Public Hearing





Questions

- Compared 12 cities across the state
- 8 not allowed Greensboro, Winston-Salem, Kernersville, Charlotte, Concord, Durham, Harrisburg, Huntersville
- 4 cities allow with limitations Asheville, Chapel Hill, Raleigh, Wilmington





Asheville

- Allowed in Central Business District,
 Shopping Centers and Historic Districts
- Maintained in good condition
- Between 8 and 24 Sq. Ft.
- May not contain commercial advertising message, name or, logo
- Maximum 60 days per year





- Chapel Hill
 - Max 32 sq. ft., 8 Ft in height
 - Limited period of display (undefined)
 - Undergoing rewrite
- Raleigh
 - Number: max. 3 signs
 - Size: max. 40% of allowable signage
 - Height: not exceed 20 ft or tallest bldg.
 - Allowed for special event (undefined) not to exceed 30 days





- Wilmington
 - Max 30 Sq. Ft.
 - CBD and Historic Districts
 - 30 days, twice per year
 - Commercial and multi-family
 - One flag
 - 30 days, one time per calendar year
