WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of High Point, North Carolina (the 'City') deems it advisable to provide parks and recreation facilities located in the City; including, without limitation, the City Lake Park project; and

Section 1 The City Council of the City has ascertained and hereby determines that it is necessary to provide for parks and recreation facilities located in the City, including, without limitation, the City Lake Park project.

Section 2. To raise the mone-required for the purposes de-scribed above, in addition to funds which may be available for such purpose from any oth-er source, bonds of the City are er source, bonds of the City are hereby authorized and shall be Issued pursuant to the Local Government Bond Act of North Carolina. The maximum aggregate principal amount of such bonds authorized by this bond order shall be and not exceed \$5,300,000.

Section 3. Taxes will be leved in an amount sofficient to pay the principal and interest of the bonds authorized by this bond

to public inspection.

Section 5. This bond order will take effect hinly (30) days after its publication following adoption, unless it is petitioned to a vote of the people within thirty (30) days after its publication as introduced, as provided in N.C.G.S.
