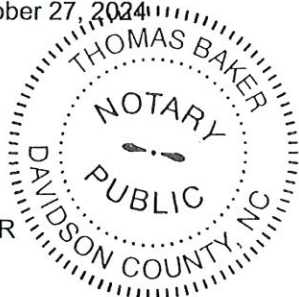

Pursuant to N.C. General Statute 158-7.1, notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the High Point City Council on Monday, March 7, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, High Point Municipal Building, 211 S. Hamilton Street, High Point, NC, for the purpose of receiving public input on a funding request from a company considering locating at 432 N. Wrenn St. in High Point, NC. The company proposes leasing and activating 4,900 sq' of space. The High Point City Council will consider authorizing incentives of 45%, 35%, 25% and 15% respectively in years 1-4 of the client's lease of space. These incentives could be up to \$102,518. The source of local funding would be the High Point Economic Development Incentive Fund, which is funded by general and electric revenues. The City would be authorized to provide this financial assistance upon the company's lease and activation of space in the downtown municipal service district – pursuant to an incentive performance agreement containing benchmarks and a schedule for the payment of such financial assistance.
