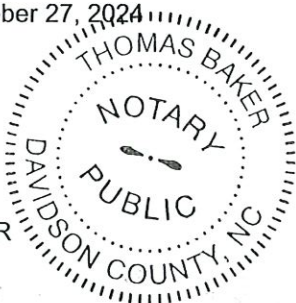

Pursuant to N.C. General Statute 158-7.1, notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the High Point City Council on Monday, March 7, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, High Point Municipal Building, 211 S. Hamilton Street, High Point, NC, for the purpose of receiving public input on a funding request for local incentives. A company proposes to locate and expand at 400 N. Elm St. in High Point, NC and invest or cause to be invested \$315,000 in building improvements and upfits. The High Point City Council will consider building upfit incentives of up to \$75,000 for the project. The High Point source of funding would be the Economic Development Incentive Fund, which is funded by general and electric revenues. The City would be authorized to provide this financial assistance upon the company's investments in real and personal property – pursuant to an incentive performance agreement containing benchmarks and a schedule for the payment of such financial assistance.
