PURPOSE:

This theatrical system is used to raise and lower theatrical lighting and scenery, draperies.

BACKGROUND:

High Point Theatre was constructed in 1975 and serves as a state of the art performing arts and meeting center for the City of High Point and the region. The rigging system currently being used was installed during that construction, and has been well maintained, but the age of the pulley's and blocks are deteriorating beyond what is acceptable for public assembly/stage use. Per recommendation from rigging inspectors and theatrical consultants dating to 2004 it was determined that be best course of action is to replace the current system. Bids for this project were opened on March 13, 2015. The funds for this project were approved during the 2014/15 fiscal year budget. The curtain portion of this project was completed in August, 2014 for \$49,317.36. The original recommendations/estimates from rigging suppliers and our theatrical consultant was that this project would cost between \$450,000-\$500,000 to replace the rigging, draperies and possibly add the smoke hatch winch system and the additional stage level control for the motorized rigging. Please note that there will be some minor additional expenses for this project, they are not a part of the rigging bid.

RECOMMENDATION /ACTION REQUESTED:

High Point Theatre is recommends that Council approve the contract with SECOA in the amount of \$263,109.00. This includes two add-alternates that we were not certain would fall within the approved budget for this project. 1. Refurbishing the Smoke Hatch Life Safety System and 2. Stage level control for the motorized rigging.
