PURPOSE:

Award contract between the City of High Point and Compensation Claims Solution, our workers' compensation third party administrator.

BACKGROUND:

The City of High Point is currently under contract with Compensation Claims Solutions (CCS) to provide third party workers' compensation claims administration at a three year fee of \$182,700 from September 1, 2011 to August 31, 2014, and a one year extension fee of \$60,900 from September 1, 2014 to August 31, 2015.

The Purchasing Division of the Financial Services Department assisted the Department of Human Resources in developing a "Request for Proposal" and scheduling the pre-bid conference that was held on May 11, 2015. Six vendors attended the pre-bid conference.

The request for proposal included instructions to submit a three-year contract proposal with a flat annual fee to cover all administrative services. It stated that responses which include "per claim" and "medical invoice review" fees would not be considered. The following services were to be provided:

- Acceptance of open workers' compensation claims incurred prior to September 1, 2015 and all claims incurred after September 1, 2015 to include indemnity, medical only and reportable incidents.
- Processing and distribution of all required North Carolina Industrial Commission (NCIC) employer and employee forms as appropriate.
- Electronic access to any and all claim files including the ability to view files and notes, completed NCIC forms, and claims cost information.
- Assignment of a dedicated claims professional to service the City of High Point account including attendance at all mediations and hearings.
- Re-pricing of medical invoices for discounts in compliance with the current North Carolina Industrial Commission fee schedule.
- Monthly and year to date claims expense reports.

Compensation Claims Solutions, Hewitt Coleman, AS& G Claims Administration, Inc., Brentwood Services Administrators, Inc., Specialized Contract Administration, LLC and Tristar Insurance Group each submitted a bid proposal.

Based upon our analysis of the bids, we recommend that the City of High Point renew our contract with Compensation Claims Solutions due to the fact that we are receiving excellent service from them and that they were the only bidder who provided a flat annual administrative fee which covers all administrative costs, met the terms of the proposal, and were the overall low bidder.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Compensation Claims Solution's cost for three year contract is \$182,700.00. This is no increase in the cost of services from the last contract term. Contract effective date is September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2018.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

Council is requested to authorize the appropriate city official to execute a 3-year contract with Compensation Claims Solution in the amount \$182,700.00, for the third party administrator workers compensation services.
