PURPOSE:

In accordance with State law, the City Council must conduct a public hearing to receive comments with regards to City Council's consideration of an installment financing contract to pay for the Motorola Communications System Upgrade over the next 10 years.

BACKGROUND:

The issuance of any debt obligation (bonds, notes, financing agreements, and leases) of the City requires the authorization of the City Council. The issuance of an installment financing contract (also sometimes known as a capital or financing lease) is authorized by G.S. 160A-20.

Due to the amount and length of proposed financing period, the statute requires approval of the Local Government Commission. As required for that body's approval, a public hearing on the proposed financing must be conducted by the City Council.
