PURPOSE:

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has requested concurring action for the extension of the 35 mph speed zone northward on North Main Street (SR 1009) for approximately 0.9 mile, to a point approximately 0.2 mile north of Old Winston Road/Belle Avenue.

BACKGROUND:

The existing 35 mph speed zone on N. Main Street terminates at a point approximately 0.3 mile north of Oxford Place, in the vicinity of Hobby Lobby. From this point northward towards I-74, the speed limit is 45 mph.

NCDOT conducted an evaluation to lower the 45 mph zone to 35 mph, based on traffic congestion, driveway density, and crash history along the N. Main corridor. This segment of N. Main Street is populated by a number of large retail establishments, including Walmart, Lowes, Hobby Lobby, and Food Lion. In addition there are several gas stations, fast food restaurants, and other businesses with primary access to N. Main.

Traffic volumes on N. Main in this area are estimated at 22,000 vehicles per day. There are approximately 40 driveway cuts, four public street intersections, and three traffic signals along this segment, which measures less than one mile in length. Over the five-year period from June 2010 through May 2015, 219 crashes were reported.

NCDOT has submitted Certificates of Municipal Declaration for concurrence with the speed limit change for City Council consideration.

BUDGET IMPACT:

None. The cost to add or change out signs can be absorbed as part of normal operations.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

The Department of Transportation has reviewed the evaluation by NCDOT and recommends City Council approval of the Certifications of Municipal Declaration to repeal the existing 45 mph speed limit and enact the proposed 35 mph speed limit. Article P of the City's traffic schedule will be amended to reflect these changes.




EXHIBIT A: NORTHWARD EXTENSION OF 35 MPH SPEED ZONE
