PURPOSE:

To provide wood poles for year 2016

BACKGROUND:

Each Year the City of High Point participates in an ElectriCities joint bid to purchase wood poles. For the year 2016 this process was competed at the end of November and ElectriCities provided the data to us in December. Bids were received from 3 vendors supplying CCA and Penta treated poles. Currently we use wood poles for two types of installations, CCA for back yard lights and Penta for all other applications.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funds are included in the 2015-16 budget to cover this expense.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

Council is requested to authorize the City to sign the ElectriCities contract with the two lowest responsive bidders; <u>United Wood Treating for \$16,344.00 (CCA poles) and McFarland Cascade for \$82,252.50 (Penta poles)</u>.

On November 13, 2015, ElectriCities of North Carolina, Inc. received cooperative bids for wood distribution poles required by each of the participating municipalities. This was carried out under the Municipal Cooperative Bid Agreement for Wood Distribution Poles executed by the City of High Point and other participating municipalities in accordance with § 160A-460 et. Seq. of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
