BACKGROUND:

The City received a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the State of North Carolina Department of Commerce. These funds are available on a reimbursable basis and must be matched at a rate of \$1.43 for every grant dollar. One of the purposes for this grant was to purchase addition property for the City's Library Plaza Project. The City has secured an option on the property located at 816 North Elm Street, in the amount of \$375,000. A map showing the location of this property is included in this agenda packet.


