# RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A PUBLIC HEARING DATE FOR VOLUNTARY CONTIGUOUS ANNEXATION (Case # ANX 16-01)

WHEREAS, the City Council has been petitioned to annex the property of 4008 Mendenhall Oaks, LLC. The proposed annexation site is approximately 6.3 acres and is lying along the east side of Eastchester Drive, approximately 560 feet south of Mendenhall Oaks Parkway.
