On November 23rd, I noticed a sign with a large "Z" located two doors down from my home. Not knowing what it was about, I approached the sign only to see there was a zoning meeting on December 8th in High Point, NC. The nature of the meeting was not disclosed.

My wife called the number on the sign and was informed this meeting was about constructing a cell phone tower right in the middle of a residential neighborhood.

After speaking with several neighbors, it appears nobody was informed of previous meetings even though the city of High Point claims they were.

Colfax is a small town located between Greensboro and High Point, NC, and is one of the most sought after areas for real estate due to its convenient location and top performing schools.
