Section 108 Loan Guarantee Program


- Allows cities to secure large federal loans to pursue CDBG eligible projects.
- Available funding is 5 times CDBG allocation.
- The first application was awarded \$3.907 million on May 3, 2010.
- Section 108 funds financed loans for Addington Ridge (58 units) and Kirkwood Crossing (84 units).
- \$3.35 million of the authorization was utilized.




New Section 108 Loan Application

- Based on 2014-15 allocation \$694,000 is expected to be available.
- A new application is required to access the unspent authorization.
- A public hearing is required to begin the process.
- Requires amendments to action plan and consolidated plan.
- The funds will assist in property acquisition and site improvements.
- The loan will support workforce multi-family housing development.
- Contingent upon state approval, the development will yield 72-84 units.

- 2-15-16 First public hearing (begins 30 day comment period).
- 3-18-16 Section 108 public comment period ends.
- 3-21-16 Conduct 2nd section 108 public hearing before Council.
- 3-22-16 Submit section 108 application to HUD.
- 5-13-16 Submit action plan to HUD.
- 5-16-16 Final application due to NC Housing Finance Agency.
- August 2016 project award announcements by NCHFA.
