PURPOSE:

The Customer Service Department purchases water meters to replace aging equipment and for new service installation.

BACKGROUND:

As water meters age they under record flow which results in lost revenue to the City. To recover that lost revenue the City replaces aged meters with new meters which read more accurately and allow for remote reading.

Customer Service anticipates installing 2,000 5/8" water meters during Fiscal Year 2016-2017. This quantity covers both replacing of aged meters and installation for new service. Meter pricing has increased due to 60W ERTs being discontinued and replaced by 100W ERTs. The newer ERTs support greater data storage and retrieval.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funds are included in the 2016-17 budget to cover this expense.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

The Customer Service Department recommends that City Council award this contract to Carolina Meter and Supply for the purchase of the water meters.
