RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION TO ACQUIRE A PORTION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN CONNECTION WITH THE KERSEY VALLEY LANDFILL ELECTRIC LINES

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of High Point hereby determines that it is necessary and in the public interest to acquire an easement across a portion of the real property at 1330 Kersey Valley Road, Guilford County, North Carolina.
- **WHEREAS**, the proper officials or representatives of the City of High Point have been unable to acquire the needed easement in this property by negotiated conveyance; and
- WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the City that the City Attorney be authorized to institute civil proceedings to condemn said property and that the Director of Finance issue a draft to the Clerk of Superior Court as just compensation to the owner in the amount of \$1,815.00;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT THAT:

- the City of High Point shall acquire an easement across a portion of the real property at issue;
 - title to a portion of that certain property located 1330 Kersey Valley Road, Guilford County, described in Deed Book 3125, Page 23 of the Guilford County Registry.
- the City Attorney of the City of High Point is hereby directed to institute the necessary proceedings under Chapter 40A of the North Carolina General Statutes to acquire an easement across the said portion of property;
- 3. the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to issue a draft in the amount of \$1,815.00 to the Clerk of Superior Court as just compensation to said owners.
