PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Supplemental Agreement is to perform engineering design work associated with constructing the City's priority sidewalks in various locations around the city. The proposed arrangement utilizes an existing on-call Master Agreement for professional services with US Infrastructure of the Carolinas, Inc. City Council is asked to approve the Supplemental Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Over the past several years, HPDOT has developed a pedestrian/sidewalk plan to identify pedestrian patterns and critical needs in our community's sidewalk system. Using information gathered from field investigations, citizen and City Council input, HPDOT staff created a top 20 priority listing of new sidewalk needs and a list of critical "missing gaps". City Council directed staff to begin work on the design of these projects. Engineering Services staff began collecting survey and property data in order to move forward with the design. In the spring of 2016, we elected to utilize one of our "on-call" engineering firms to complete the design work for these sidewalks due to current staff work loads. Engineering Services negotiated a scope with US Infrastructure of the Carolinas to design approximately 22,874 linear feet of sidewalk.

We now respectfully ask that City Council consider and approve this supplemental agreement. The scope of the work is contained in Attachment A for the lump sum fee of \$95,378.00. Under this agreement, the City is responsible for providing all survey work.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funding for this Supplemental Agreement is available in the FY 2016-2017 budget.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff recommends approval of this Supplemental Agreement in the amount of \$95,378.00.

SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR CONCRETE SIDEWALKS

The City of High Point is seeking to enter into a supplemental agreement with US Infrastructure of Carolina, Inc. to provide professional engineering services for various proposed concrete sidewalks in High Point, North Carolina. All design work shall be in conformance with the MASTER AGREEMENT for ON-CALL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES, PUBLIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT dated April 5, 2013.

Some topographical surveying has been completed by the City of High Point and will be provided for this work.

1. CONCRETE SIDEWALKS (5' WIDE)

- a. Scope of Services
 - i. Coordinate with the City of High Point Engineering Services Department for the proposed locations and design specifics for twenty-two (22) proposed concrete sidewalk projects. The total combined length of the projects is 22,874 LF.
 - ii. Prepare complete design plans for each of the twenty-two proposed concrete sidewalk projects.
 - iii. Provide the final designs in AutoCAD format to the Engineering Services Department.
 - iv. Provide the necessary specifications to be incorporated into the final construction contract. The City of High Point will prepare the final construction contract.
 - v. The City of High Point will provide construction inspection services to ensure that what is being constructed is in accordance with your design.

2. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- a. Scope of Services
 - i. Some additional topographical and property surveying work may be necessary.
