PURPOSE:

The Landfill has a 2010 CMI/Terex 550 landfill compactor that was purchased from Onslow County that is in need of replacement. Using a piggyback purchase from Macon County, NC a CMI Model TM11 from CMI Roadbuilding is being recommended for City Council approval.

BACKGROUND:

The Landfill purchased a 2010 CMI/Terex 550 from Onslow County in 2014 for \$15,000. The compactor has worked well, but needs to be replaced. The Kersey Valley Landfill currently has five Terex compactors (three active, two spares) and have been very pleased with the compaction and service from these machines. Operator training requirements are minimized since they are using a similar type of equipment. Also, maintenance contracts can be done with one company versus multiple companies which makes the entire process for getting parts and service easier and more economical. We plan to retain the old compactor for parts due to low resale value.

The price of \$718,100 includes the compactor, 5 year/10,000 hour extended warranty, and maintenance software. Estimated delivery is 240-360 days.
