PURPOSE:

City Council will consider a request from TQL to authorize up to \$70,000 in performance-based incentives for the company's expansion.

- The company would add 70 new jobs in High Point over five years.
- The average base wage would be \$36,000 per year. With commissions, compensation should average at least \$43,900 in Year 2 and \$46,900 in Year 5.

BACKGROUND:

TQL – Total Quality Logistics – is the second largest freight brokerage firm in North America.

- TQL connects companies needing products hauled with carriers delivering goods.
- The company's headquarters is in Cincinnati, Ohio. It was founded in 1997 and today employs more than 4,200 people.
- The company currently has NC operations in Charlotte and near Research Triangle Park.
- TQL is considering opening a facility at 4135 Mendenhall Oaks Parkway in High Point. High Point and locations in several other states are under consideration for this project.

BUDGET IMPACT:

If the company meets all of the benchmarks outlined in a performance agreement, it could receive up to \$70,000 in installment payments. The source of that funding would be the City's Economic Development Incentive Fund, which is funded by general and electric revenues.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

The High Point EDC staff recommends that the City Council:

- authorize up to \$70,000 in performance-based incentives for the TQL project; and
- authorize the city manager to execute a performance agreement with the company, containing benchmarks for the company to achieve and a schedule for the payment of such financial assistance.

Pursuant to N.C. The City would be authorized to provide this financial assistance upon the company's job creation – pursuant to an incentive performance agreement containing benchmarks and schedule for the payment of such financial assistance.
