**PURPOSE:**

As part of our ongoing water system maintenance, the City of High Point wishes to replace old/obsolete and or broken valves in various strategic locations throughout the city. Council is asked to approve contract 2016-010 for Water Valve Replacement.

**BACKGROUND:**

This contract work is to replace existing broken water valves on the City of High Point system. Replacing these valves will give the City better operational control of the water system and improved emergency response. The work includes: 42 individual water valves ranging in size from 6 inches to 12 inches, ductile iron water pipe, iron fittings, and other incidental items required to complete the work. Most of these water valves are in excess of 50 years old. Engineering Services will inspect the work and administer the contract.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

Funding is available in the FY 2016-2017 Annual Budget.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Engineering Services Department and Public Services Department recommend that Council approve this contract award to Breece Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$275,620.00 and authorize the appropriate city official to execute all necessary documents.
