PURPOSE:

A request by Community Development and Housing – Local Codes Section to adopt an ordinance ordering the inspector to demolish the dwelling at 1215 E. Green Drive.

BACKGROUND:

After a Complaint and Notice of Hearing was issued and a hearing held, an Order to Repair or Demolish was issued on 11/23/16. No action occurred by the compliance date of 1/17/17. The necessary repairs to the dwelling exceed its current tax value and the demolition is warranted.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funds are available in the Department budget for the demolition and asbestos testing of the structure(s), and for the asbestos removal if present.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff recommends the adoption of the requested ordinance to demolish this single family dwelling and any accessory structures located on the same parcel.

PENDING ACTION:

The ordinance becomes effective 30 days from the date of adoption. If there is no action by the property owner by the effective date of the ordinance, then asbestos testing and the demolition bid process will begin and the structure will be removed by the City. After City demolition, the property owner is billed for the cost. If the bill is unpaid, the City places a lien on the property.

RESULTS: The owner Mr. Lewis did appear for the Hearing. During the Hearing it was determined there are several violations of the Minimum Housing Code. There are multiple structural violations in the house that make it

unsafe. In its present state, necessary repairs to the dwelling exceed

50% of the value of the structure.

ISSUED: Order to Repair or Demolish 11/23/16 Date of Compliance 1/17/17

APPEALS: No appeals to date.

OWNER

ACTIONS: No repairs started or permits applied for or issued.

EXTENSIONS: None granted.

ADDITIONAL: The inspector spoke with Mr. Lewis on 1/19/17 about his plans for the

property. Mr. Lewis stated that he was concerned about putting money into the house and then Council would issue an Order to Demolish anyway. Mr. Lewis was reminded that if he started work on the

property and showed progress prior to going to Council in the form of permits, materials on hand and inspections that the City would work with him on extending the compliance date. Mr. Lewis asked if he would be notified of the council meeting, which he was told he would

be. Also, 2016 Taxes are delinquent in the amount of \$620.57

SECTION 1: That the City Council of the City of High Point finds as a fact that the following described property has been ordered to be demolished, and it further finds as a fact that the owner has been ordered to demolish said building at his expense and said Owner has failed to comply with said order.

SECTION 2: That the Inspector of the City of High Point is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the demolition of the following described building in accordance with code of Ordinances: and, Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
