### **PURPOSE:**

The City has budgeted for the replacement of the Bethel Drive Pump Station.

### **BACKGROUND:**

This project is part of the overall upgrade of lift stations throughout the City of High Point. The low bidder is an experienced contractor properly licensed by the State of North Carolina. The existing station requires replacement due to settlement of the wetwell and the age of the existing equipment. This station was constructed in 1975.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

Funds for this project are available in the FY 2016-2017 budget .

### **RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Public Services Department recommends approval of the contract and that the appropriate City official be authorized to execute all necessary documents to award the project to D.H. Griffin Infrastructure, LLC in the amount of \$658,000.00.

Bids were received by the Purchasing Department yesterday for the above referenced project. A total of three bids were received and opened. Our certified tabulation of the bids is attached, and a summary of the bids are as follows:

Bidder	Amount of Bid
DH Griffin Infrastructure, Greensboro, NC	\$ 658,000
TA Loving Company, Goldsboro, NC	\$ 760,000
Haren Construction Co, Etowah, TN	\$ 822,000

The lowest bidder on this project is approximately 5.3% higher than the estimated construction cost updated by our firm after plans were completed. All three contractors listed the same subcontractor and equipment suppliers. DH Griffin is a properly licensed utility contractor and is capable of performing the work required by the Contract.

Based upon the information presented above, DMP recommends the City of High Point City Council consider awarding this contract to DH Griffin in the amount of their total bid of \$658,000.


