PURPOSE:

The City budgeted for replacement of its existing trommel screener at Ingleside Compost Facility. The trommel screener removes waste and larger items from the compost to provide a clean processed material to the customer base.

BACKGROUND:

The existing trommel screener is 12 years old. The typical service life is 8 to 10 years. The existing screener has been well maintained but has exceeded its useful life. This equipment is needed to continue processing clean material for the customer base. The recommended unit is available through NJPA (Contract # 042815-TER).


The machine offered by Powerscreen Mid-Atlantic, Inc. will meet all of the needs of Ingleside Compost Facility to provide clean material to the customer base.
