#### **PURPOSE:**

Establish a public hearing date of Monday, October 2, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. for the purpose of receiving public comments on the funding for the JAG Grant.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The City of High Point is proposing to use the 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistant (JAG) funding to purchase in-car cameras for nine patrol vehicles. Funding will be presented to City Council in the form of public hearing and comment on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017. The grant funding is a multi-agency grant with the City of Greensboro, High Point and Guilford County Sheriff's Department. The City of Greensboro is the acting fiscal agency for the JAG Funding. The City of Greensboro will receive funding of \$113,616; The Guilford County Sheriff's Department will receive funding in the amount of \$53,205.80; and the City of High Point will receive funding in the amount of \$42,423.20. The HPPD will use the funding to purchase nine (9) new in-car digital cameras at a total cost of \$46,530.00. The (9) new cameras will replace aging, out-of-date cameras. Additional expenses will be paid from the North Carolina Tax Proceeds.

#### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

There is no required match for this grant.
