#### **PURPOSE**:

A Budget Amendment is requested to appropriate State funds for an additional appropriation for the Safe Routes to School sidewalk project.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Transportation Department has worked with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) to secure funding through the Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS) program for sidewalk construction around several elementary schools in High Point. On September 15, 2014 City Council approved an agreement that provided \$500,000 in Federal construction funds for sidewalk improvements in proximity to five area schools: Oak Hill Elementary, Fairview Elementary, Shadybrook Elementary, Johnson Street Elementary, and Triangle Lake Montessori

Over the course of project development, construction costs have increased dramatically. The lowest competitive bid received in November exceeded the project budget by almost \$600,000. Staff reached out to NCDOT for additional funds, and received acknowledgment earlier this month of funding availability from the Department.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

A budget amendment in the amount of \$560,000 will be provided through the NCDOT Transportation Alternatives Program.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:** The Budget Department recommends and asks the Council to approve the budget amendment.

- (A) That General Capital Projects Fund revenues be amended as follows:

(B) That the General Capital Projects Fund expenditures be amended as follows:

Capital Projects Expenditures

\$560,000
