#### **PURPOSE**:

This chemical product is used at the City's Water and Wastewater Treatment Facilities for treatment plant processes.

#### **BACKGROUND**:

Alum is used at the Ward Plant for coagulation. It is used at Eastside and Westside WWTP for phosphorous control. This contract is for the supply of chemical to each of the following plants:

Ward Water Treatment Plant (WTP)
Eastside Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP)
Westside Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP)

This renewal will be for one year with Chemtrade (Bid # 20-012115) at a 4.2% increase from \$239 per dry ton to \$249 per dry ton.

Dear Ms. Rush,

As you are aware, Chemtrade currently supplies the City of High Point with the product Liquid Aluminum Sulfate (Alum) under Bid # 49-020316. Chemtrade has been supplying this product for many years, and have supplied under the current bid contract since March 2016.

Over the past year Chemtrade has incurred cost increases for the Alum we manufacture and deliver to the City of High Point. Most notably, the increases have to do with higher costs of Sulfuric Acid, although we have also seen increases in aluminum bauxite, freight and plant overhead for maintaining trucks and keeping and paying responsible, qualified, and safety minded employees and equipment.

Chemtrade's costs for producing Alum are expected to increase by over \$15 per dry ton for 2018. Chemtrade would appreciate the consideration of an extension of the current bid contract for an additional term with a price increase of \$10.00 per dry ton (4.2%) to assist with the mentioned cost increases we have seen. The current price is \$239 per dry ton, and the new requested price would be \$249 per dry ton. The new price would be effective and held firm for the next contract period of March 1, 2018 through February 28, 2019.

Chemtrade values the long standing relationship we have with the City of High Point, and we look forward to continuing our relationship and business for a long time to come.
