#### **PURPOSE**:

To hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering projects for which capital, operating, and planning assistance under Section 5307 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended, is being sought.

### **BACKGROUND**:

The Department of Transportation is in the process of preparing the FY2019 FTA Section 5307 operating, capital and planning grant application for High Point Transit. In order to comply with federal and state guidelines a public hearing must be held allowing the opportunity for citizens to comment on the projects in the grant application. The filing of the grant application with FTA and NCDOT also be must authorized by City Council.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

This public hearing allows the City to apply for federal and state funds which make up approximately 56% of the transit system's FY2018-2019 budget.

### RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

June 18, 2018 – Public hearing is held, and Council authorizes filing of grant applications to FTA and NCDOT and passes authorizing resolution to enter into agreements with NCDOT.
