PURPOSE:

The Water & Sewer Division of Public Services is currently using a 2006 Ford F450 with a sewer pipeline camera system that is in need of replacement due to age and condition. Using a HGAC contract a Ford Transit with a Aries brand sewer camera system is being recommended for council approval.

BACKGROUND:

The Water & Sewer Division is currently using a 2006 Ford F450 with a sewer camera system that is 12 years old and is in need of replacement. This truck is used daily for inspecting clogged sewer lines and performing routine maintenance. The sewer camera system has been demonstrated onsite by the dealer and proven to meet their requirements. The price of \$196,028 is for the truck with sewer camera system, training, and delivery which is estimated at 180-210 days.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:
