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**PURPOSE:**

The High Point Fire Department is currently using a 2003 KME Pumper Tanker, and a 2004 Pierce Tractor Drawn Aerial that need to be replaced due to age/hours and current Fleet Replacement Plan. Using the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) cooperative contract, the High Point Fire Department is requesting Council's approval for the purchase of one (1) Pierce Enforcer Pumper/Tanker and one (1) Pierce Tractor Drawn Aerial.

**BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1901, Standard Automotive Fire Apparatus, the City of High Point adopted a 15-year Fleet Replacement Plan for fire apparatus. The current apparatus stated is/has approached its 15-year front line lifecycle and has combined over 230,000 road miles and 20,000 pump/engine hours.

Upon delivery of the Pumper Tanker and Tractor Drawn Aerial, the 2003 KME pumper tanker and 2004 Tractor Drawn Aerial will be transferred to reserve status. The two (2) Pierce apparatus have a purchase price of \$2,057,442.00 which is itemized at \$631,303.00 for the Pumper Tanker and \$1,424,139.00 for the Tractor Drawn Aerial. Once the receipt of purchase order, the expected delivery could range from 240 to 360 days.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

Funding is available in the 2018-19 budget with proceeds from an installment financing contract that will be administered by the Financial Services Department.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Fire Department recommends approval of the contract for the purchase of two (2) 2018 Pierce Apparatus from Atlantic Emergency Solutions in the amount of \$2,057,442.00 and that the appropriate City official and/or employee be authorized to execute all necessary documents.
