#### PURPOSE:

Consideration of a Supplemental Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) to increase State funding and extend the required completion date of a project for improvements at the intersection of North Main Street and Lexington Avenue.

### BACKGROUND:

In 2011, the City entered into a Municipal Agreement with NCDOT that secured \$140,000 in State funds for traffic signal and pedestrian improvements at this intersection. Over time this project has evolved into a more complex and comprehensive effort, with the scope of work now including the replacement of century-old water and sanitary sewer lines running through the intersection, and the construction of an underground duct bank to be used for the future relocation of aerial electric and communication lines.

A subsequent Supplemental Agreement with NCDOT, executed in 2015 to extend the project completion date, has expired. This new Supplemental Agreement increases State funding by \$100,000 (to a total of \$240,000) and sets April 30, 2020 as the new project completion date.

## **BUDGET IMPACT:**

Current cost estimates for the intersection improvements is anticipated to be in the range of \$275,000 to \$300,000. The City is responsible for all constructions costs exceeding the \$240,000 award, as well as costs associated with and necessary easements and utility adjustments. Funding for these expenses are available from funds set aside for improvements to N. Main Street.

### RECOMMENDATION and ACTION REQUESTED:

The Transportation Department recommends approval of this Supplemental Agreement. Project design and contract preparation by Engineering Services staff is nearing completion, and construction of the improvements is expected to begin in late spring, after the upcoming Home Furnishings Market.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on the last date executed below, by and between the North Carolina Department of Transportation, an agency of the State of North Carolina, hereinafter referred to as the "Department", and the City of High Point, hereinafter referred to as the "Municipality."

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Department and the Municipality on 8/31/2011, entered into a certain Project Agreement for the original scope: Install pedestrian amenities on US 311 Business (Main Street) at Lexington Avenue in High Point.(Wheelchair ramps, crosswalks, pedestrian signal heads, and traffic islands), programmed under WBS Element 43250; and,

WHEREAS, on 7/11/2012 and 4/6/2015, the parties agreed to extend the completion date for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to increase the funding and extend the completion date for the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties wish to supplement the aforementioned Agreement whereby the following provisions are amended:

### **FUNDING**

The Department's original participation was \$140,000. The Department agrees to reimburse the Municipality an additional \$100,000 of Contingency funds.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Municipality shall complete the project by 4/30/2020 in lieu of 6/30/2016.

Except as hereinabove provided, the Agreement heretofore executed by the Department and the Municipality on 8/31/2011 and amended on 7/11/2012 and 4/6/2015, is ratified and affirmed as therein provided.
