PURPOSE:

The Financial Services Department recommends that the City Council update the resolutions for authorizing depository agreements for those active depository and investment institutions to be effective upon adoption.

BACKGROUND:

The authorization of City depositories for operational accounts and investments is required by NC General Statute 159-30. Associated with that law, City Council also authorizes individuals by virtue of their position to deposit and disburse funds in accordance with the City's business.

The attached resolutions update the financial institutions with which the City currently conducts deposit, disbursement and/or investment relationships. Upon adoption, the resolutions will affirm City Manager Greg Demko, Kelly Latham, Assistant Financial Services Director, Heather Forrest, Accounting Manager and Ashley Grindstaff, Accounting Supervisor, and add Bobby Fitzjohn as authorized individuals with whom our banks and financial institutions will do business on behalf of the City of High Point.

“RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DEPOSITORY AGREEMENT WITH BANK OF AMERICA AND THE CITY
OF HIGH POINT

WHEREAS, the City of High Point, a Municipal Corporation existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina, desires to designate Bank of America as a depository of this Municipal Corporation; and,

WHEREAS, that a deposit account and/or certificates of deposit and/or other evidences of investments be opened and maintained in the name of the City of High Point, with said financial institution in accordance with applicable rules and regulations for such an account(s); and,

WHEREAS, the Financial Services Director or his assistant, upon adoption of this resolution, be authorized on behalf of the City of High Point, and in its name to sign checks, drafts, notes, bills of exchange, acceptances, certificates of deposit or other orders for the payment of money; to endorse checks, notes, bills, certificates of deposit, or other instruments, owned or held by this Municipal Corporation for deposit with said bank or for collection or discount by said banks; to accept drafts, acceptances and other instruments payable at said bank; to execute and deliver an electronic funds transfer agreement and to appoint and delegate, from time to time, such persons who may request transfers on behalf of this Municipal Corporation; to establish and maintain a night deposit relationship; to establish and maintain other banking services coincidental to the establishment of said bank as an official depository; to waive presentment, demand, protest and notice of protest or dishonor of any check, note, bill, draft or other instrument made, drawn or endorsed by this Municipal Corporation;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Bank of America is herewith designated as an authorized depository of the City of High Point as of March 4, 2019m, and that one or more checking and/or other deposit accounts be opened and maintained with Bank of America; that any of the following employees, to wit:
