The NC Department of Transportation has agreed to widen National Service Road to accommodate left and right turn lanes and tapers at two proposed acces points on National Service Road west of Piedmont Triad Parkway. RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT

REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS TO NATIONAL SERVICE ROAD

WHEREAS, G.S. 136-11.1 requires that the North Carolina Department of Transportation ("NCDOT") request a resolution from all municipalities and counties affected by certain planned transportation projects to express their views on the project prior to any action taken by the North Carolina Board of Transportation ("Board"); and

WHEREAS, the Department has proposed committing in excess of \$250,000 for the improvements that include the widening of National Service Road to accommodate turn lanes and tapers at the two access points; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 136-11.1, the City is provided the opportunity to state its views on the Project through this resolution before action of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Department and the Board shall consider, but shall not be bound by, the views of the City regarding the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City supports the Project because it will enhance the safety of the traveling public in the area and requests the Department and the Board approve the Project.
