- WHEREAS, April marks the 51<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the passage of Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, also known as the federal Fair Housing Act, which sought to eliminate discrimination in housing opportunities and to affirmatively further housing choices for all Americans; and
- **WHEREAS**, the State Fair Housing Act was passed in 1983 to further enforce the fundamental right of fair housing opportunities for North Carolina residents; and
- **WHEREAS,** illegal barriers to equal opportunity in housing, no matter how subtle, diminish the rights of all; and
- WHEREAS, housing is a critical component of family and community health and stability; and
- WHEREAS, ongoing education and outreach are key to raising awareness of fair housing principle, practices, and responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS, the City of High Point supports and encourages fair housing for all residents; and
- WHEREAS, "Fair Housing Month" is time set aside each year to remind Americans that we not only have the right to own and rent property, but it is an individual responsibility to guard this right from any infringement; and
- **WHEREAS**, equal housing opportunity is a condition of life in the City of High Point that can and should be achieved;
