- WHEREAS, the City of High Point recognizes the contribution of senior citizens to our community. The longevity of life is a blessing for a community which benefits from the knowledge, and experiences of its residents; and
- WHEREAS, the United States has the greatest number of centenarians in the world, and today we are honoring Ms. Delphine Tucker Gibson for 114 years on this earth.
