### **PURPOSE:**

The Public Services Department and the Engineering Services Department ask City Council to award contract 2019-002 for Storm System Improvements to KRG Utility, Inc.

### **BACKGROUND:**

On Wednesday, April 3, 2019 the City of High Point received bids for Contract ENG-2019-002. We received three responsive bids:

KRG Utility, Inc.	\$765,597.00
Breece Enterprises, Inc.	\$967,110.00
Yates Construction Company	\$998,145.00

The availability date of this contract is immediately upon execution of the contract documents. The completion time for the contract work is 270 consecutive calendar days.

The purpose of this contract is to make storm system improvements in 7 different locations around the city. These projects are being funded through the Stormwater Ongoing Projects account. The following projects are included in this contract:

Lower Regency Dam Repair, Dogwood Court Storm System, Parkwood Circle Storm System, Arbrook Lane Storm System, Madison Street Storm System, Kearns Avenue Dry Pond Construction, and Fairway Drive Storm System.

The contract had to be re-bid due to a lack of bidders on the first attempt. These projects were designed by city staff.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

Funding is available in the 2018-2019 Annual Budget.

### **RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

Council is requested to approve the contract to KRG Utility in the amount of \$765,597.00 for Storm System Improvements.
