2019-141 <u>Estoppel Certificate- IHFC Properties SPE, LLC</u>

Council is requested to authorize the Mayor to sign the Estoppel Certificate with regards to the IHFC Properties SPE, LLC lease for the property located at 210-220 E. Commerce Avenue.

City Attorney JoAnne Carlyle explained that because the City is the lessor of IHFC, it requires them to come to City Council every time they refinance. She noted that it is basically providing the City notice of the refinancing and IHFC needs to be approved so they can close and get the monies transferred. Staff recommends approval of the Ground Lease Estoppel.

Approved the Estoppel Certificate with IHFC Properties SPE, LLC with regards to the IHFC Properties SPE, LLC lease for the property located at 210-220 E. Commerce Avenue and authorized the Mayor to execute the Estoppel Certificate.

She questioned their request and their motive for wanting the language removed and expressed concerns about donating the property to Jamestown if they are contemplating selling it for a profit. She advised that Jamestown has not made a formal request to have the language removed and she also questioned whether or not the language could be removed anyway.
