WHEREAS, on August 3, 1949, President Harry S. Truman signed an act of Congress designating June 14th of each year as National Flag Day; and,

WHEREAS, in partnership with the Alexander Martin Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, a special celebration of Flag Day will take place on Saturday, June 15 at 10:00 a.m. at the High Point Farmers Market at the High Point Public Library; and,
