# RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A PUBLIC HEARING DATE FOR VOLUNTARY CONTIGUOUS ANNEXATION (AN-19-06)

- WHEREAS, the City Council has been petitioned to annex the property of Soulin Pasit and Som Put Pasit. The proposed annexation site consists of an approximate 1.6-acre parcel lying along the east side of Penny Road, approximately 650 feet south of Eagle Glen Road. The property is also known as Guilford County Tax Parcel 227820.
- WHEREAS, the City Clerk is in receipt of said petition and has determined its sufficiency in accordance with G.S. 160A-31;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL establishes Monday, August 19, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Building at 211 South Hamilton Street, High Point, North Carolina, as the date for the public hearing regarding the requested annexation.
