## RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 3.1 METHOD OF ELECTION OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT TO IMPLEMENT FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. §160A-102 a city council may amend its city charter by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.C.G.S. §160A-101(4) for the terms of office for the City Council shall be two or four years; and

WHEREAS, currently the terms of office for High Point City Council Members are two-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the High Point City Council desires to change the terms of office to four-year terms beginning with the 2019 municipal election; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.C.G.S. 160A-102 a public hearing on a proposed charter amendment shall be called for not more than forty-five (45) days after the adoption of a Resolution of Intent; and

WHEREAS, a notice of said public hearing shall be published at least once, not less than ten (10) days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing, and shall contain a summary of the proposed charter amendment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing for the Amendment of Article III, Section 3.1 of the City Charter of the City of High Point changing the terms of office for the City Council from two-year terms to four-year terms, in accordance with N.C.G.S. §160A-102 and §160A-101(4) beginning with the 2019 municipal election.
