#### **PURPOSE:**

To approve an early construction package with Samet Corporation (CMAR) to allow renovations to begin immediately on the new High Point Police Headquarters and Communications Center located at 1730 Westchester Drive.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

At the March 18, 2019 City Council Meeting, City Council approved a contract with Samet Corporation as the Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) for the new High Point Police Headquarters and Communications Center. In order to begin renovations immediately, an early construction agreement in an amount not to exceed \$5,017,482.00 needs to be approved by City Council.
