RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A PUBLIC HEARING DATE FOR VOLUNTARY NON-CONTIGUOUS ANNEXATION (AN-19-12)

- WHEREAS, the City Council has been petitioned to annex the property of Triad Industrial Partners III, LLC. The proposed annexation site is approximately 31.15 acres and located along the north side of Gallimore Dairy Road, approximately 3,000 feet west of Pegg Road. The site is addressed as 780 and 800 Gallimore Dairy Road and is also known as Guilford County Tax Parcels 169780 and 169762.
- WHEREAS, the City Clerk is in receipt of said petition and has determined its sufficiency in accordance with G.S. 160A-58.2;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL establishes Tuesday, January 21, 2020, at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Building at 211 South Hamilton Street, High Point, North Carolina, as the date for the public hearing regarding the requested annexation.
