**PURPOSE:**

A budget amendment is needed to appropriate funds received by the City from the High Point Community Foundation for a bus shelter at Guilford Child Development.

**BACKGROUND:**

An anonymous donor made a \$5,000 donation to the City through the High Point Community Foundation to fund a bus shelter at Guilford Child Development. The City of High Point is honored to be the recipient of these funds from this donor.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

Should costs to install a shelter exceed these funds, additional funds are available in the General Capital Projects Fund.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Budget Department recommends and that City Council to approve the budget amendment in the amount of \$5,000 for the construction of the bus shelter at Guilford Child Development.

**"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT, NORTH CAROLINA  
TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR BUS SHELTER DONATION**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of High Point, North Carolina, as follows:

Section 1.      The City of High Point has received a donation for a bus shelter at Guilford Child Development.

Section 2.      The 2019-2020 Budget Ordinance of the City of High Point, should be amended as follows:

(A)      That the General Capital Projects Fund revenues be amended as follows:

Donation Revenue	\$ 5,000

(B)      That the General Capital Projects Fund expenditures be amended as follows:

Section 3.      That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
