

HPT ATTENDANCE FYE 2015-2019















HPT BOX OFFICE GROSS FYE 2015 – FYE 2019

HP Theatre Box Office Gross Sales










HPT EVENTS VS UTILIZATION FYE 2015-2019








OBSERVATIONS FOR 2019

- Total Events: 348
- Rental/Private/Promoter Events: 216
- City Sponsored Events: 132
- Ticketed Events: 76
- Reserved Hours: 2,737.5 = 7.5 hrs. 365 or an average of 12.28 hours per day of usage!
- Estimated Hotel Rooms utilized: 2,725
- Only 15 percent of total tickets issued were complimentary
 - Fewest since HPT has been tracking






CONCESSION GROWTH 2011 – 2019 \$50,000 IN GROSS SALES OVER 77 EVENTS IN 18/19

OTHER #'S OF NOTE

- FYE 2019 saw our per cap spending on concessions rise to \$1.64 per patron
 - This includes all events, even meetings that don't have concessions offered
- Sales tax collected from concessions: \$3,360
- Sales tax collected from box office sales: \$38,840.56
- 4.75 percent in state taxes + 2 percent county taxes = 6.75 percent
- Total tickets sold: 27,699
- Tickets sold on-line: 11,655
- 20 perf. w/500+ patrons, 40 perf. sold 50 percent of stock

Attendance growth from 2017/18 – 2018/19: 7 percent from 14/15 to 18/19 growth of 80 percent

Gross box office income rose by 23 percent from 17/18 and 80 percent from 2014/15

Rent: gallery increase since acoustical treatment by 530 percent

Auditorium increase from 2014/15 to 2018/19 40 percent (without changing the fees) Overall facility rental revenue increased since 2014/15 by 99 percent

Concessions: 2013/14 inc.\$20,200 per cap. \$0.96 2018/19 inc. \$52,550 per cap. \$1.64


