PURPOSE:

To authorize a contract with the United Way of Greater High Point (United Way) to assist local agencies providing services to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic that benefit income eligible persons.

BACKGROUND:

The City was awarded a special allocation of Community Development Block Grant Corona Virus (CDBG-CV) funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic. As the United Way had already established an emergency relief fund to provide COVID-19 Community Impact Support grants, staff recommended funding to the Citizens Advisory Council (CAC) to supplement their activity and expedite the infusion of CDBG-CV funding into the community. The CAC recommended an allocation of \$100,000.00 to the United Way at their meeting on April 28th.

Budget Impact:

An award in the amount of \$100,000.00 will be sourced from the CDBG-CV program.

Recommendation:

The Community Development and Housing Department recommends approval of a contract with ther United Way in the amount \$100,000.00 to assist local agencies providing services that prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic that benefit income eligible persons and that the appropriate City official and/or employee be authorized to execute all necessary documents.
