PURPOSE:

City Council has approved a lease agreement with Motorola Solutions for WatchGuard 4RE/VISTA In-car camera / body-worn camera systems to be utilized by first responders for Information Technology Services and the High Point Police Department, in amount of \$1,380,436. A budget ordinance is required to record the lease.

BACKGROUND:

Generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP) require that certain leases be capitalized and receive specialized accounting treatment. When a lease is capitalized, it requires budgetary authorization, similar to a purchase of capital equipment. The attached ordinance allows the Motorola System Core to be capitalized and does not authorize additional spending.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Budgeted expenses associated with capitalizing leases are equal to the associated accounting revenue recognized by entering into the lease. Lease payments will begin in Fiscal year 2021-22.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff recommends approval of the attached budget ordinance amendment which will allow the proper accounting of the capital lease.

"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT, NORTH CAROLINA TO APPROPRIATE CAPITAL LEASE FUNDS FOR IN-CAR AND BODY-WORN CAMERA SYSTEM

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of High Point, North Carolina, as follows:

- Section 1. The City of High Point has determined it is in the City's best interest to lease in-car and bodyworn cameras, and their underlying storage, support, and warranty, utilizing a lease agreement with Motorola Solutions.
- Section 2. The 2019-2020 Budget Ordinance of the City of High Point, should be amended as follows:
- (A) That the General Fund revenues be increased:

Lease Financing Proceeds \$1,330,200

(B) That the General Fund expenditures be increased:

Leased Equipment \$1,330,200

- Section 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 4. That this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage."
