PURPOSE:

To appropriate a pass-through grant from the NC Department of Commerce's One North Carolina Fund.

BACKGROUND:

In 2017, the City entered a Company Performance Agreement (CPA) with Superion, LLC (now Central Square) to provide certain performance-based incentives for the company's expansion in High Point. In addition to \$80,000 of local incentives, the One North Carolina Fund awarded a grant in the amount of \$160,000. The grant was to be used by the company toward the goal of creating 80 new permanent, full-time jobs and \$3,460,000 in new investment in the State of North Carolina.

The Department of Commerce has notified the City that the requirements of the grant have been satisfied and the city has received \$160,000 to be passed through to Central Square (formerly Superion, LLC).

BUDGET IMPACT:

There is no budget impact.
