RESOLUTION APPROVING SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY BY PRIVATE NEGOTIATION AND SALE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 160A-266

WHEREAS, the City of High Point ("City") is owner of a police canine ("Canine Rudo") that has proven to be ineffective for its role and has therefore become surplus; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 160A-266 authorizes the City to dispose of surplus property by private negotiation and sale with respect to personal property valued at less than \$30,000, upon authorization of the City Council at a regular meeting and notice to the public; and

WHEREAS, Canine Rudo is considered personal property and is valued at an amount less than \$30,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of High Point pursuant to the North Carolina General Statute 160A-266 that the personal property known as Canine Rudo is valued less than \$30,000, is hereby declared surplus and the City Manager is authorized to sell Canine Rudo by private negotiation and sale.
